Subject: Art Talk with Jud Turner, Sculptor

Eugene sculptor Jud Turner will give a noon-hour art talk on Friday May 16th, at which he will discuss his work on exhibit at DIVA. He will explore the creative process involved in forming his pieces formed from welded steel 3/32" rods. FREE. Bring your lunch!

Turner notes that a high premium was placed on education and creativity when he was growing up. He has always drawn, painted, and sculpted.

He received training in drawing and painting at the University of Oregon, under Professor Ron Graff and the late Professor Frank Okada, both renowned artists and educators. In the early 1990's, he transitioned to sculptural works as his main artistic output, focusing on direct welded steel work and found object assemblages.
